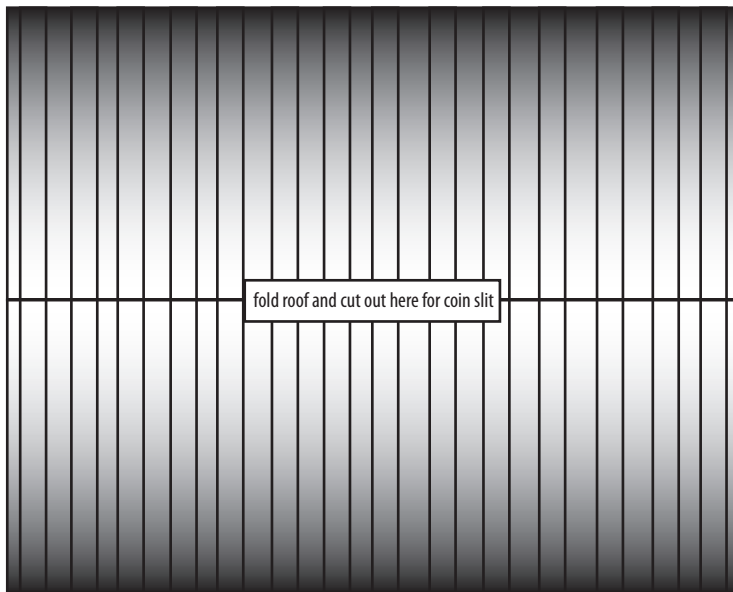


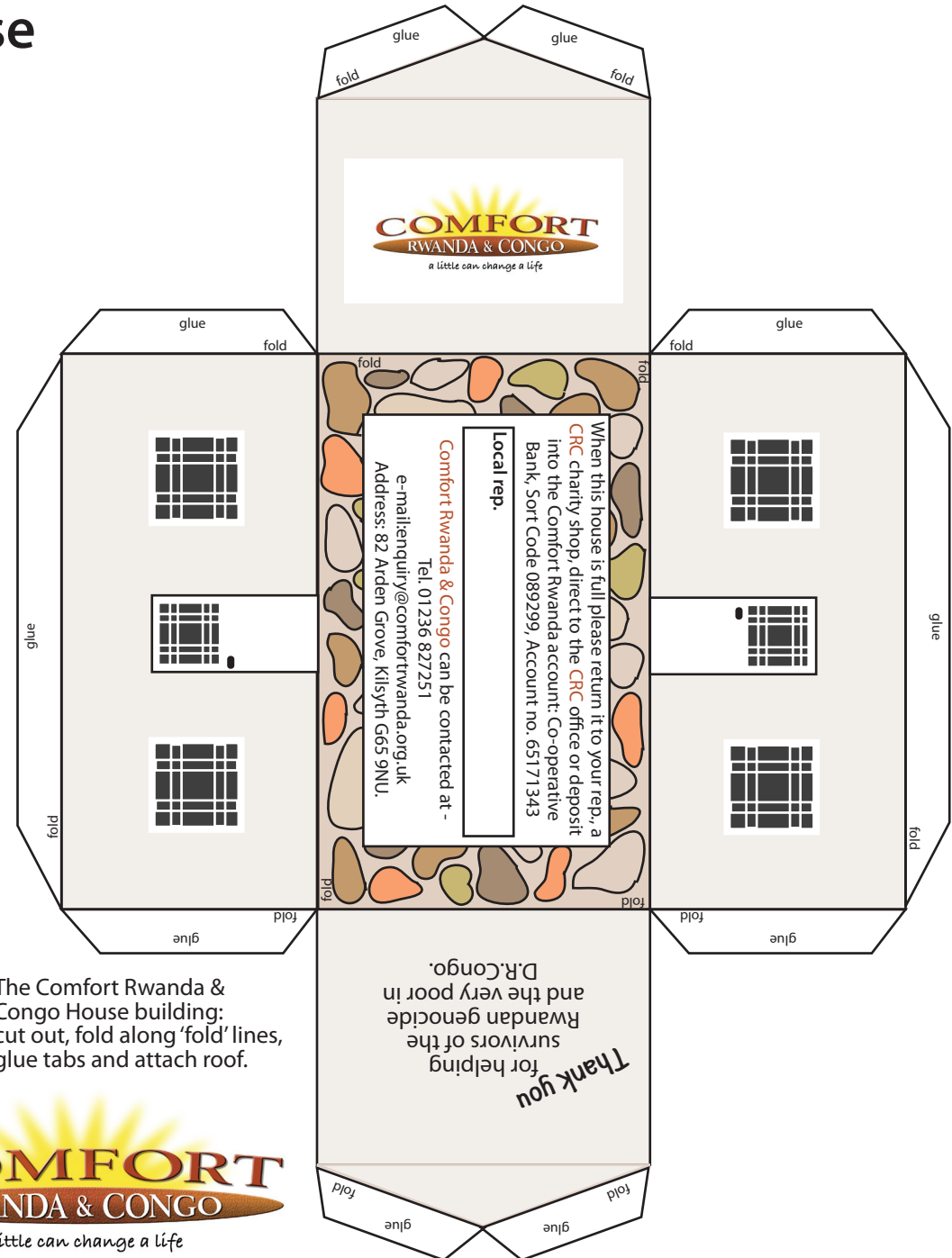
The Comfort Rwanda & Congo House

Comfort Rwanda & Congo (CRC) is bringing considerable blessing to genocide survivors in many parts of Rwanda and D.R.Congo. During the genocide in 1994 more than 1 million Rwandans were systematically and brutally killed in 100 days. Most of those who survived endured or witnessed horrific events. Orphan- and widowhood, trauma, poverty, homelessness, physical injury, displacement, division, isolation and missed education are a few of the consequences of this tragic event. CRC, together with Rwandan and Congolese partners, is committed to countering these consequences with the love and power of the gospel of Jesus Christ and by doing so bringing a hope and a future to these people. CRC supports a wide variety of projects including: Street Kids Rescue, building houses for widows & orphans, education, agricultural support, micro-finance for income generating projects, vocational training, medical care and sponsorship of needy individuals. 100% of all gifts go to the work in Rwanda. To make this Comfort Rwanda & Congo House cut out the two shapes, fold along the lines and glue the walls together. Fold the roof piece and cut out the coin slit, then glue the roof to the main building. If you want to make more remember to copy this page first onto thin card.
