Let me remind you of some good news: Jean Baptiste Hakisimana, the IVTC student who was ill is now back at classes, the support team day was very encouraging, progress is being made with the FoundationMakers support package, the recent trip to Rwanda was very good, there has been some very encouraging progress in a number of projects and the new Kyeyze school at Kiziba and the Maternity Clinic in the D.R.Congo are nearly finished, Praise God!!!

God is good and we know that His heart is to bless the people of Rwanda and D.R. Congo. Please ask God how you should pray for each of the situations below so that we see His will is done on earth as it is in heaven.

Summer Trips (25 June - 3 August): During the summer there are a number of groups traveling to Rwanda and D.R. Congo. Baldraggon Academy from Dundee will be the first, returning on 7 July, followed by Erskine Church of the Nazarene. Later a group from a variety of churches will visit D.R. Congo and Rwanda, this group will include some who will be teaching at the CTCR (pastors training). Please pray for the organisation, the protection and the unity of each group. Pray also that God will impact each person in a new or fresh way, that each one will return with a fresh revelation of the goodness, love and power of Father God. That they may be blessed to be a blessing.



The Maternity Clinic: The clinic building in North Kivu, D.R.Congo is due to be completed in July. Praise God!!! Thank God for all who have been involved to reach this stage. Equipping the clinic will be a major task. Thank God that He is provider and that he supplies all our needs according to His riches. Please pray for wisdom on whether to send a container or buy equipment in Congo and for provision to do this.



Cattle Project: Please pray for the cows!!!

Another of the cows has died recently. Please pray that we can find out the cause of the deaths and determine whether there is anything that can be done. Our current strategy is to purchase cows which are slightly less Friesian as we believe that these will be more resistant to disease. Please pray for wisdom for the herdsman and protection for the livestock. Thank God that all the calves are still healthy. Thank God, too, for a £5000 donation for the Cattle project from the United Free Church.
